All types, sizes and era of Warbirds & Military aircraft will be flown. You may see Biplanes, Monoplanes, Triplanes, Gliders & Multi-engine planes. The guarantee is that you will see plenty of model airplanes.

You may be one of the <u>lucky spectators to get an</u> <u>opportunity to try R/C flying</u>. After we describe the basic principles of R/C flight, you'll fly on the "Buddy System" - two transmitters connected by a cable. A club Intro Pilot will fly one of our R/C model aircraft to a safe altitude, controlling it with the primary transmitter. Then he will depress a switch on that transmitter to permit control by the secondary transmitter in your hands. You get to fly the plane. But don't worry; if you get the plane into trouble, he can regain control at any time by releasing the switch on his transmitter.
