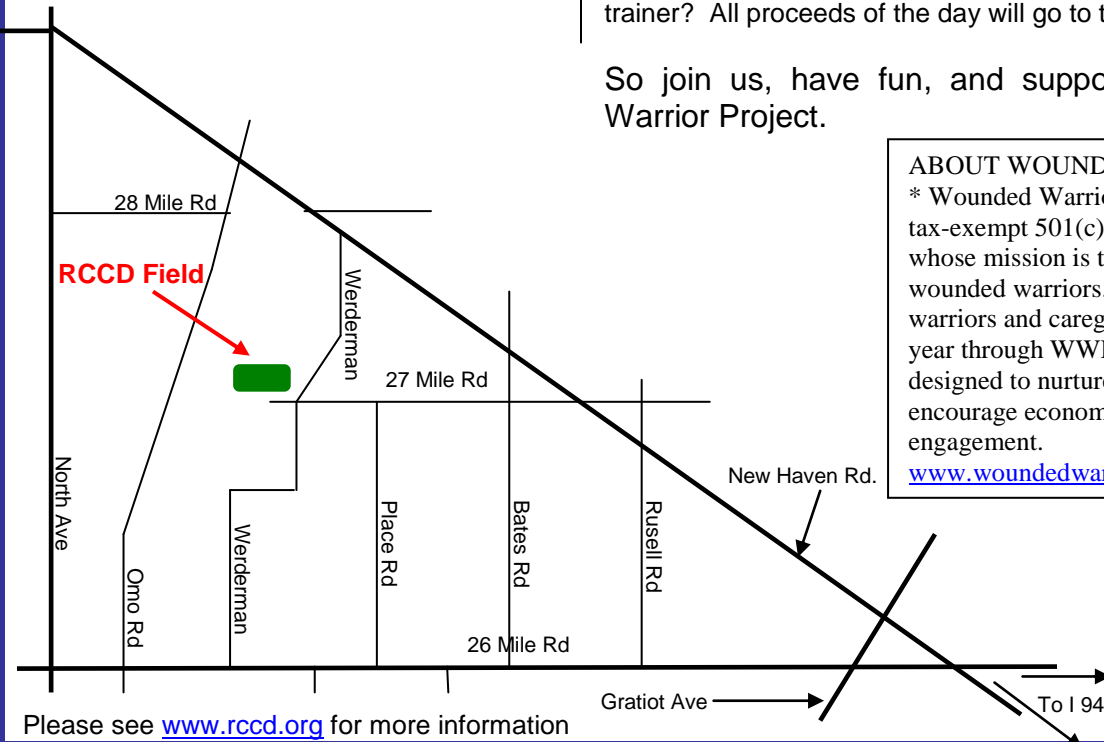
Discover Radio Control Model Aviation & Support the Wounded Warrior Project®
