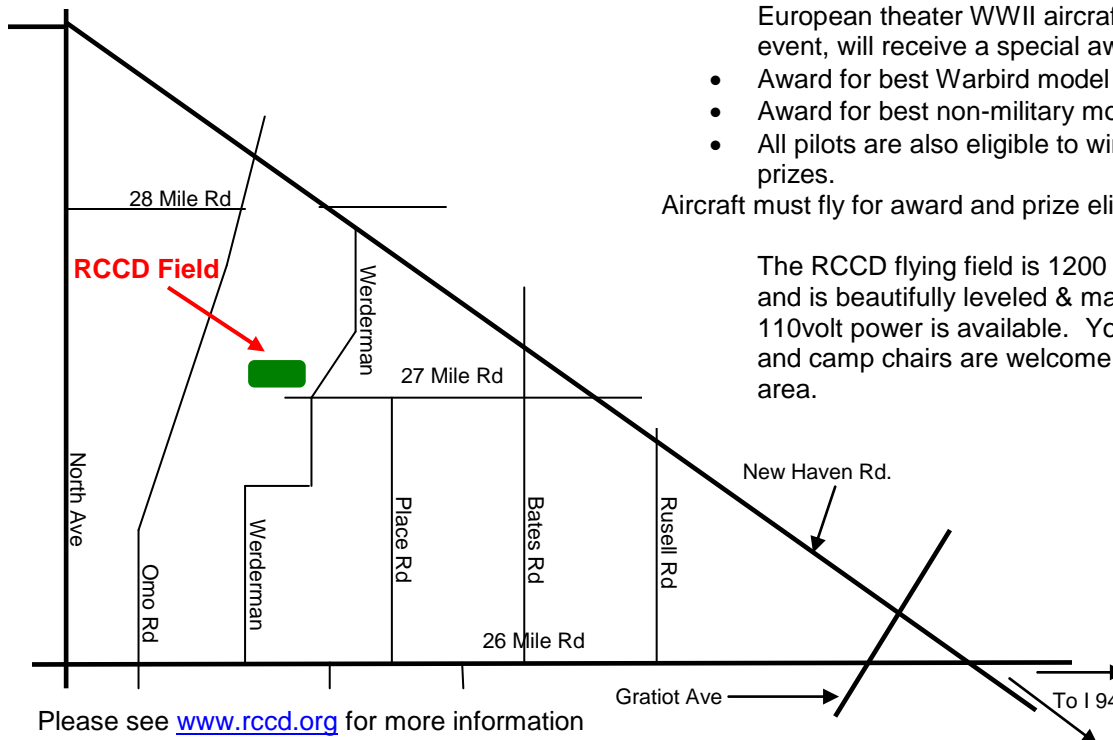

- The Battle of Britain was contested in the Summer & Fall of 1940. In observance of the 75th anniversary, the most realistic model of a European theater WWII aircraft, flown at the event, will receive a special award and prize.
- Award for best Warbird model (WWI to today).
- Award for best non-military model.
- All pilots are also eligible to win lucky-draw prizes.

Aircraft must fly for award and prize eligibility.
