# Logistics

- ▣ Drive distance is about 230 miles from Detroit
  - 460 miles round trip → about \$50 for fuel.
- ▣ Car-pool with friends
  - Perhaps rent a U-Haul trailer for your models
    - 5'x8' trailer is \$130 (incl. insurance) for 4 days.
- ▣ Hotel & Camping Options – next pages

# Camping at the IAC

- AMA provides camping for the following:
  - **Primitive Camping** – no electricity or water \$5 per night.
  - **RV/Motor home** – no electricity or water \$5 per night.
  - **RV/Motor home** – with electric hookup \$17 per night (total number of electric hookup sites 39) stay six nights and seventh night is free. We do have six full service spots cost \$20 per night stay six nights and seventh night is free.
- A RV dump station is available on site.
- All campers must register with AMA. Register during normal business hours (8 a.m.-5 p.m. Monday through Friday; Museum Store 10 a.m.-4 p.m. weekends, closed Sundays Thanksgiving through Easter) at the Administration Building or the Museum Store. Campers who use electricity and stay longer than 6 nights will receive 7 night for free.
- Dogs must be on a leash at all times. You are also required to clean up areas that your pet use.
- Due to Indiana State Board of Health requirements, all campers (primitive & RV) **MUST** register at one of the above mentioned locations. If someone arrives after hours, he/she should register first thing the next business day. This will be monitored closely!
- Golf Cart: Two electric golf carts are available at AMA HQ. Cost \$50 per day



# What to do

- ▣ Flying almost any time. No real time restrictions.  
(Want to fly that glow-powered plane in still morning air?)
- ▣ Visit the Model Aviation Museum at the site.
- ▣ Visit AMA HQ.
- ▣ Take a drive around the site to get an idea of the facilities.
- ▣ One RCCD organized dinner for attendees
  - date, location & cost TBD
  
- ▣ Visit the National Air Force Museum near Dayton, on the way there or on your return.
  - Drive distance via National Air Force Museum is about 530 miles. (+ 70 miles)

# What to Bring

- ▣ Your “good” models.
  - Did we mention there’s LOTS of space?
- ▣ 2.4 GHz radios only
- ▣ Flight line equipment.
- ▣ Charging equipment for TX, RX and/or Flight batteries. No on-site 110V supply.
- ▣ Repair tools and supplies.
  - Which we hope will not be needed!
  - *Toys Forever Model & Hobbies* is about 4 miles from the site.
- ▣ A pop-up shelter – there is no shade at the sites.
  - Or to share with someone, get agreement before the trip.
  - Make sure you have means to stake it against wind.
- ▣ Camp chairs.
- ▣ A cooler with water/pop
  - And perhaps some after-flying beverages
- ▣ ETC. (this is not a comprehensive list)
