Awards and Prizes:

- 100 years ago, pilots were being trained in large ٠ numbers for battle in WWI: 75 years ago, for WWII; 50 years ago for Vietnam. In recognition of the aircraft they trained in, the most realistic model of a military trainer, flown at the event, will receive a special award and prize.
- Award for best Warbird model (WWI to today).
- Award for best non-military model.
- All pilots are also eligible to win lucky-draw prizes.

Aircraft must fly for award and prize eligibility.
