FUN FLY EVENTS:

PVC Ring Drop: (*The same aircraft must be used for the PVC Ring Drop & the Climb & Glide)
The closest to drop a PVC Ring to the center of a 10ft. diameter circle wins (all material will be supplied).

Climb & Glide: (*The same aircraft must be used for the PVC Ring Drop & the Climb & Glide)
Pilot has exactly 30 seconds from moment of take-off to gain altitude under power, after which the motor must be cut and plane kept aloft as long as possible (altitude limited to 400ft. and that also means you must dive as fast as possible if a full scale aircraft is in the area since we are a couple of miles from a full scale airport).

Two Minute Touch 'N' Go:
Time starts at takeoff. Pilot performs as many touch and go maneuvers as possible in two minutes.

Drag Race:
With wings removed. four planes will drag race on a straight course for approximately 100ft. Fastest time wins. There will probably be two different Drag Race classes. For example: a 40's and 50's size engine class, and 60's and up (No jet engines allowed). The class split will be based on how many people and what size engines there are, so there aren't too many people in one class and not enough in the other.
